21. Empowerment Program to Address the Digital Divide in Underserved Communities

Revised recommendation as submitted by Supervisors Solis and Barger: Authorize the Director of Internal Services to establish a proposed program to empower youth and small businesses in underserved communities that are adversely impacted by the digital divide and connect them to technology, resources and opportunities; and instruct the Director of Internal Services, in consultation with County Counsel, the Director of Children and Family Services, the Acting Directors of Consumer and Business Affairs and Workforce Development, Aging and Community Services, the Office of Diversion and Re-Entry's Youth Development and Diversion Division, and the Superintendent of Schools of the Los Angeles County Office of Education, to report back to the Board in 90 days with a program implementation plan.
